Assessment Review Board

There are three seats on the Board of Assessment Review. Currently, the Chairman is Donna Brown. Other members are George Erdman Jr., and Candy Brown. The Board of Assessment Review holds Grievance Day on the fourth Tuesday of May from 4:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. at the Fowler Town Hall.

Residents who disagree with their assessment are urged to meet with the Town Assessors to discuss their assessments PRIOR to presenting their grievance to the Board of Assessment Review. To make arrangements to meet with an assessor at the Town Hall, please call the Assessors at the phone number listed in the Directory or call the Town Clerk at (315) 287-0045.

If residents wish to grieve their assessments, they may do so at the date and time previously outlined. The Board will review grievances and then make a decision to either lower the property owner’s assessment or leave the assessment the same. Residents who have filed a grievance are notified of the outcome by U.S. Mail.

Justice Department

In November of 2017, Ryan Young was elected as Fowler Town Justice. Court is held every Wednesday at 6 PM upstairs in the Town Hall. Fines may be paid at that time or sent in the mail. The Court does not accept checks.

Town Board

In the year of 2018, the town board meetings will be held on the first Tuesday of each month at 7pm except for the month of November. Special meetings will be advertised in the Gouverneur Tribune Press and/or the Watertown Daily Times newspapers and also on the town's website. www.fowlerny.com

The current Town Board consists of three incumbents, Deputy Supervisor and Councilman Ricky W. Newvine, council persons Karen Simmons, Lynn Bishop, as well as newly elected councilman Jeff Andrews and Supervisor Michael Cappellino.

Ms. Barbara Finnie will continue to oversee the duties as bookkeeper in 2018.

The town has worked closely in 2017 with the St. Lawrence Co. Housing Authority. Fowler housing rehabilitation using the grant monies from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) was completed in Fowler in 2017.

Sylvia Lake Public Beach - 29 Old Beach Road, Gouverneur NY 13642

The Public Beach is owned and operated by the Town of Fowler. The beach is open seven days a week from the end of June to the end of August. Certified lifeguards are on duty during the posted hours of operations. (10:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.) Handicapped and public parking is located near the beach entrance. The beach has a picnic area with tables and charcoal grills for public use. Changing rooms and rest rooms are also available.

Highway Department

The Town of Fowler maintains 56.25 Miles of Town Roads. In the winter months the town plows 73.75 road miles including County Route 22 and 24.

We appreciate everyone’s patience this past year during our busy 2017 construction season. During this period, we resurfaced 6.5 miles of Town Roads. These roads consisted of the Hull Road, Main Street-Hailesboro Road, Jones Road, Bay Road, and the Island Branch Road.

I would like to extend a special thanks to Steven Fuller who stepped in to help us out during the construction period to replace one of our permanent employees who was off work on Compensation. I would also like to welcome Sid Harmer Jr. to the team. He replaced Lyle Bishop who had 24 years of faithful service to the town.

In 2018, we are planning on resurfacing another 6 miles of town roads and have many roads prepared now. The number of road miles resurfaced in 2018 will depend solely upon the price of asphalt at that time.

Town Planning Board

Since there are no zoning laws in the Town of Fowler the Planning Board makes its decisions and submits them to the Town Board according to the Town’s Land Use Policy.

Planning Board meetings are held the last Tuesday of the month as needed or when necessary at 7 PM in the Fowler Town Hall. Meetings are advertised in the local newspaper and on the Town of Fowler website.

Ethics Board

The Fowler Board of Ethics Committee consists of five members: Lillith Griffith- Chairperson, Vicky Cappellino, Karen Simmons, Alex Mackinnon and Phyllis Shaw. Each member serves a four-year term.

Any person may file a concern or complaint in writing to the chairperson who in turn will set up a meeting with the other committee members to address the issue. The committee may request an interview with the party or parties involved to discuss the situation further to reach a decision or solution. After the discussion, the committee notifies the party or parties of their decision in writing.

From the Assessors

Our newly elected assessors are Phyllis Shaw and Andrew Miller. They will be working with Chairperson Sherry Geer. If you are a Veteran with an honorable discharge you may be eligible for one of the following exemptions:

Alternative Veterans Exemption (form RP-458-a)- available only on residential property of a veteran who has served during a designated time of war or received an expeditionary medal.

Cold War Veterans Exemption (form RP-458-b) – available only on residential property of a veteran who served during the Cold War period.

Eligible Funds Exemption (form RP-458) – provides a partial exemption. Applies to property that a veteran or certain other designated person purchase. Such owners must purchase the property with pension, bonus, or insurance monies.

How to Request an Exemption:

Eligible Veterans must submit the initial exemption application form with all necessary documentation to the assessors. The deadline for filing for a Veterans' Exemption is March 1st, 2018 for the 2018-2019 Assessment Roll. For additional details, including filing deadlines and applications, please contact your local tax assessor's office.

Code Enforcement Office

As of November 1, 2017, 62 building permits had been issued. Building permits are required for demolition of buildings, renovations, structural changes on your home or buildings, roof replacement, pools, and buildings over 144 sq. ft. The Town also received two written complaints that were resolved.

There are changes to the Building Code effective as of October, 2017. If you have any questions about code regulations or concerns about unsafe or unsanitary conditions within the Town, please call Glen Besaw (Code Enforcement Officer) at (315) 323-0761.
